


Please make sure the gold contact area on the SIM2 is facing upwards, and the SIM1 is facing downwards.

b. Insert Micro SD card

- To insert a Micro SD card, place the card connector towards the front side of the device and the printing side of the card towards the rear side of the device.
- To remove the micro SD card, pull the card out of the slot.

5. Charging

- Insert one end of USB cable into the USB port on the device and plug the power adapter to the electrical socket.
- Normally it takes approximately 3.5 hours to fully charge the device. Operating the device while charging with the AC adapter may extend the charging time.





- Press and hold the Power Button for a few seconds. It will automatically enter the Home screen after start-up screen.
- Press the Power Button once to enter sleep mode and press it again to awake the device.
- Press and hold the Power Button, and then tap on Power off/Standby to power off the device or to enter sleep
