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Simple Troubleshooting Guide

The following checklist might helped to solve the problems which you meet when using the unit. Please double check and make sure if the connection and the procedure of the operation is properly before using the checklist below .

Problem	Cause/Solution
No power.	• Check and make sure whether the fuse is blown, replace with the proper value if necessary.
Some errors occur in the LCD or no function when pressing the button.	Press RESET button.
Unable to receive stations.	• Check and make sure whether the antenna is inserted or the antenna is properly connected, if not, insert the antenna or connect it properly.
Poor effect on receiving a station.	 Antenna may not be the proper length. Make sure the antenna is fully extended; if broken, replace the antenna with a new one. The antenna is poorly grounded, check and make sure the antenna is properly grounded at its mounting location.
CDs cannot be loaded.	• A CD is loaded in the mechanism.
Sound skips.	• The CD is dirty or damaged.
No images.	• The Video line from main unit to the TV is not connected properly.
Images skip.	• Improper setting of the color system. Set the color system to "PAL" or "NTSC" according to the connected television.

Note:

If any of the problem persist after check list had been made, consult your nearest service dealer. Never attempt to disassemble your unit by yourself.

Due to continuous product improvement, the operations are subject to run the model.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS About this manual

- 1 Be sure to connect the color coded leads according to the diagram. Incorrect connections may cause the unit to malfunction or damage the vehicle's electrical system.
- 2 Be sure to connect the speaker (-) leads to the speaker (-) terminal. Never connect the left and right channel speaker cables each other or to the vehicle body.
- 3 Make sure all the connections are completely correct before turning on your unit.
- 4 When replacing the fuse(s), the replacement must be of the same amperage as shown on the fuse holder.
- 5 Do not block vents or radiator panels. Blocking them will cause heat to build up inside and may result in fire.
- 6 To lest the driver distrack his attention from, please install the unit in an apt place.
- 7 Using the unit after starting the engine, otherwise the unit can not be started, because the electric energy of battery was used up.
- 8 The unit must be screened from direct sunlight, or the electric energy of battery will be wasting for the high temperature.
- 9 Do not use the unit in extreme high temperature or such low temperature conditions, and also avoid humidity and direct sunlight.
- 10 Take care of the magnetism of the unit. Do no put the credit card, cassette or watch around the unit, or they would be broken or some information in them lose.
- 11 To lest disturb the video frequency, keep far away from the unit when using your phone.
- 12 Do not put the remote control under high temperature or where the sun strikes it, or else the control remote can not work normally.

This unit features a number of sophisticated functions ensuring superior operation. All the functions have been designed for the easiest possible use, but many are not self-explanatory. This manual will help you understand the functions and operations of the unit. This manual main explains **remote control operation.** However, in addition to those functions related with DVD/VCD/CD/MP3/MP4 operation that can only be operated by the remote control, there are also functions can be operated by the buttons provided for the main unit.

AUX Touch Screen Menu

Press SRC to switch to the AUX mode:

Bluetooth Mode

To Dial by the Unit

when cellphone is connected, press 3 to input the call number, then press 3 \backsim to dial, *DIAL OK* appears, when the call is pick up, and it appears *PICK UP*.

Note:

- Press CLEAR on the remote control or S in the monitor to delete wrong inputs.
- * Press > on the unit or 2 perform the same function.

Using the Unit as Bluetooth Music

During bluetooth mode, the musics on the cell phone switch to the unit for play. To select music fast: press (1) K to play the previous track, press (1) to play the next one.

Pause play: press \bigcirc >II to pause play. Stop play: press \bigcirc I to stop play, and press the PLAY to play the current track again.

Note:

- * Press and hold ◄ / ► on the head unit to select tracks fast.
- * Press and hold ③ on the head unit to pause play.
- * Stop play is operated by using the remote control only.

Audio Transfer between the Unit and Phone

Press 6 to change the conversation from the unit to the cell phone.

Note:

* The function will be cause to be disconnected bluetooth link for Nokia phones, but you do not worry just press 6 button while private conversation with Nokia phones,then switch back to the unit automatically.

- Do not attempt to modify the unit, modifying the unit may cause an accident.
- Stop the vehicle before carrying out any operation that could interfere with your driving.
- Do not work in extremely high or low temperature. Be sure the temperature inside the vehicle is between +60° C and -10° C before turning on your unit.
- To enjoy optimum sound and images while playing, handle the discs as follows:

Handle the disc by its edge to keep the disc clean, and do not touch the surface.



— Do not use your CDs with paste residue or ink attached.



——Do not use CDs with labels or stickers attached, which may leave a sticky residue while beginning to peel off. (Shown as the picture)



Clean the discs with an optional cleaning cloth. Wipe each disc from the center out. (Shown as the picture)



Besides playing the discs above, the unit also can be connected to other connector. Please refer to the details on page <u>19</u> before you playing them.



Bluetooth Mode

Maintenance

Replacing the Fuse

Make sure the amperage matches the specified value when replacing the fuses. If the fuse is blown, check the power connection and replace with a new one. If the same problem occurs, it would be subjected to the malfunction. In such cases, please consult to the nearest service dealer.

A Warning

Never use the fuse with the rated amperage more than that supplied to your unit, otherwise it will damage the unit.

Replacing the Battery

When the range of the operation of the card remote control becomes short or no functions while operating. Replace the lithium battery with a new button cell (CR2025). Make sure the battery polarity before replace.


Gently pull out the Battery Holder while pressing the Stopper.



Put the button-type battery with mark(+) upward into the Battery Holder.



Insert the Battery Holder into the Remote



Precautions on Using Lithium Battery

Always keep the lithium battery beyond children's reach. In case swallowed, see a doctor immediately.

Cleaning the battery with a dry cloth, to ensure its perfect connected.

Make sure the proper polarity when loading with the battery.

To prevent short circuit, do not use metal tweezer to clip the battery.

Warning

Improper handling with the battery may lead to explosion. It cannot be charged, disassembled or thrown into a fire.

Cellphone Pairing Mode

- 1. Browse your cell phone menu and find the connectivity or Bluetooth connection section.
- 2. Select *search for* a new handsfree device function and allow the phone to find the **mobile**.

(Different cell phone has different bluetooth menu, please refer to your phone manul.)

3. When CAR A/V DEVICE appear, select this item.

(if it can not be connected, please refer to mobile manual, and connect it again.)

- 4. To input the password, the password is: 1234.
- Press the connect with the Handsfree option on your cellphone, and CON-NECTED appears.

Bluetooth Connection and Disconnection

When established bluetooth connection between this unit and the cell phone, bluetooth icon (2) on the display appears in red. Press (2) PAIR to turn off bluetooth connection, and (2) appears in blue. Press (2) ,*PAIRING SUCCESS* appear on the display, then display shows *CONNECTED* when bluetooth connected; display shows

PAIR TIME OUT, when bluetooth

disconnected.

Note:

- * Please keep the phone battery is full of power,or else the bluetooth connection will be disturbed.
- * To ensure connection succeed
- ----Please delete menu of cell phone with bluetooth.
- ----Please reset the unit and cell phone.
- ----Please reset every step of pairing.
- * Disconnect after paring
- ----Please pair the phone in manual.
 - For example: pairing fixture \rightarrow cell phone \rightarrow connect.

- * Pressing PAIR on the head unit or **(5)** in the monitor also performs the same function.
- * Pressing _____ in the monitor to turn off the bluetooth function.

Using the Unit as a Handsfree Device

When the unit is ringing, then it appears call from and the phone number ID***** *****on the dialing,

To accept call: Press to answer a call, it appears *PICK UP* on the display. To reject call: Press **() (** to reject a call, it appears *REJECT* on the display. To end call: Press **(** to end call, and *HANG UP* appears on the display.

Note:

- * Some of cellphones do not support reject call during bluetooth mode.
- Press and a on the unit or and a performs the same function.

Last Number Dialing

Press O button, it appears last call number on A, press \frown again, and then *PICK UP* appears on the display during conversation.

- Note:
- Press rightarrow on the unit or rightarrow perform the same function.
- * To dail the number of the unit in the car only.

To Dial by Cell phone

- 1. The unit activated automatically when you make a call by cellphone, and *DIAL OK* appears.
- 2. When you receive a call, *PICK UP* appears on the display.

Using a Bluetooth Wireless

Connection

The device can be dialed wirelessly in bluetooth status. Before using the bluetooth function, please turn on your cell phone bluetooth function.

Note:

- * To provide the best sound without or little distorted sound(the cellphone or network brings).
- * Full duplex conversation.
- * Bluetooth ver2.0 compliant.
- * Please dial-up the device before connecting bluetooth.

Pairing Your Unit and Bluetooth Phone

The device supports handsfree profile, headset profile, A2DP (Audio Advanced Distribution control profile) and AVRCP (Audio Video Remote Control profile). Follow the pairing instruction for the first time use, after that the unit will connect automatically.

Pairing in Handsfree Mode


- 1. Press **PAIR**, and **PAIRING** shows on the screen.
- 2. To get into *CELL PHONE CONNECTION* to search fixtures;
- 3. If the cellphone has connected, *PAIRING SUCCESS* appear and then *CONNECTED* in order, will from blue to red.





RDS Setup

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Press it to activate AF function.

2 TA Press it to activate TA function.

3 ▲ / ▼ Press it to select PTY code.

- **4 PTY** Press it to activate PTY function.
- **5** During PTY ON, press this button to search the playing track' s type.
- 6 BACK

Press it to turn to listening to the radio.

7 PS:

TO display the current RDS station' s programs information.

SEARCH+/-Press it to tune automatically.

Alternative Frequencies

Briefly pressing **3** AF to activate the auto searching station function. When AF is on, the RDS signal is week or there is not, it will be found in the preseted frequencies and the whole bands.

Note:

* It is also performed by pressing **1** in the monitor.

Traffic Alarm

Briefly pressing S TA to activate the traffic alarm function. When AF is on, there is **TA** displays on LCD, or else, if there is no TP information,the mode will search TP station automatically.

The *TA* is green when it is played by a station, if not, it is yellow.

When TA is playing, the volume will be adjusted to a TA level automatically When in other modes (such as DVD,AUX), if a TA program is played. The mode will skip to the RDS status automatically. It will resume to the primary mode after the TA is over.

Note:

- * Briefly press TA on the head unit or **2** in the monitor performs the same function.
- * When TA is off, there are no *TA* on LCD.

Program Type

Briefly pressing **7** PTY to activate PTY function.

When PTY is on, *PTY ON* appears in the monitor, you can press **UP/DOWN** to select the program type, and then press PTY CODE to search the special program. And the monitor displays *PTY SEARCH*.

If PTY is off, <u>**PTY OFF**</u> appears in the monitor, the searching is stopped.

Note:

* It is also performed by pressing **4** in the monitor.



MO/ST Selector

Press **6 ST** button on the remote control to select **MONO** mode or **STEREO** mode.

Stereo reception is charged when "STEREO" appears. It is switched to mono mode when "MONO" appears. "ST OFF" appears on the display to switch to MONO compulsively.

Note:

- * It is only valid on remote control.
- * Switch to MONO compulsively to improve the listening quality when week signal.
- * It is only valid in FM tuning.

Scanning/Memorizing Stations Automatically

During radio status, briefly press 4 AMS button on the remote control to scan each stored station 5 seconds respectively which stored in 3 Number Buttons (from 1 to 6). You can press the corresponding Number Buttons or AMS button when your desired station is charged. And it starts playing that station.

When press and hold **④ AMS** button for more than 2 seconds, it will activate automatically memory storing function. The radio automatically selects a station and has it stored in any one of the **④ Number**

Buttons (from1 to 6).

Note:

- * The unit can be stored up to 6 stations for each band.
- * It is only valid on remote control.

Number Buttons

During radio status, press **Number Buttons** to receive the stored stations.

During radio status, **Number Buttons** (from 1 to 6) ② can help you store your favorite station. You can follow the steps as below:

1 When receiving a station, press and hold any one of the **Number Buttons**

(from 1 to 6) until the number appears on the LCD, which indicates that station is already stored in the corresponding number button.

- 2 Press and hold **(***AMS* button to receive stations automatically, and store them in 1 to 6 number respectively.
- 3 Press and hold another number button more than 2 seconds when listening in a station in one number button's, the station will be stored in that number button.
- Note:
- * Press (5) in the monitor performs the same function.

On Screen Display

During radio mode, briefly press **8** OSD to enter RDS SETUP, press and hold it to display the edition information and the LCD display the current time.

Note:

* Press 7 in the monitor to enter RDS SETUP.



1 Band Indicator

Shows which band the radio is tuned to.

Briefly press to tune by the presettable range, hold and press to tune automatically.

Band Selector

During radio status, repeatedly press **3** BAND button to select bands in the following order:



* Press BAND on the head unit or <u>6</u> in the monitor performs the same function.

Manual/Automatic Tuning

Manual Tuning: Press O (\blacktriangleright or \Huge{I}) button on the remote control continuously to select a station downward or upward respectively.

Automatic Tuning: Press and hold O (\blacktriangleright or \Huge{O}) button for more than 3 seconds, the radio automatically searches a station downward or upward respectively and plays when it finds a station.

Note:

* Press ► / ◄ on the head unit or ④ in the monitor performs the same function.

DX/LOC Selector

During radio status, press S LOC button to select strong or weak station reception.

"LOC ON" appears on the display and only local station is available. "LOC OFF" appears on the display both distance and local stations can be received.

Note:

- * The function is only valid on remote control.
- * The function is invalid in AM tuning.

Selecting the Stored Station

During radio status, press 0 \blacktriangle button to select the stored station upward, press \checkmark to select the stored station downward.

Note:

The function is only valid on remote control.

Before You Start

Selecting Tracks Fast

During MP4(AVI,MPEG4) playback,first press **(1) (** to return to the beginning of the current track, press **(2) (** again within 3 seconds to play previous track ,press **(2) (** to play next track .

Note:

* Pressing and ▶ button on the head unit or and m in the monitor also performs the same function.

Skip backward/forward/F.F /F.REW the playback

Press O (\nleftrightarrow or \nleftrightarrow) on remote control to perform fast reward or fast forward.Each pressing will change as follow:

 $\xrightarrow{2X} 4X \xrightarrow{8X} 16X$

Note:

* Press and hold ◄ and ▶ button on the head unit or ◄ and ➡ in the monitor also performs the same function.

Playing Tracks at Random

During MP4(AVI,MPEG4) playback, press **() RDM** button on the remote control to play any track at random under the directory which you select. Press it again to cancel this function.



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* The function is only valid on remote control.

Increase the size of the picture

During MP4(AVI,MPEG4) mode, Press **200M** to increase the picture in size. There are sizes as follow, Each pressing increases the size until the maximum size is reached.



Note:

- * The function is only valid on remote control.
- * To remove the image by pressing 29 button.

Changing audio language (Multi-audio)

With MP4(AVI,MPEG4) disc featuring multi-audio recordings, you can press **6 AUDIO** to switch between language and audio systems during playback.

Selection options switch as follows:

AUDIO 1 — AUDIO 2 — AUDIO 3.....

Note:

- * This function is operated by using the remote control.
- This function only operates with disc featuring multi-audio recordings.
- The number in the "⑦" mark on a disc package indicates the number of recorded languages/audio systems.

Changing the subtitle language (Multi-subtitle)

With MP4(AVI,MPEG4) disc featuring multi-subtitle recordings. You can press **SUB-T** to switch between subtitle languages during playback.

Selection options switch as follows:

Subtitles 1 — Subtitles 2 — …… — Subtitles OFF

Note:

- * This function is operated by using the remote control.
- * This function only operates with disc featuring multi-subtitle recordings.
- The number in the " " mark on a disc package indicates the number of recorded subtitle languages.



Note:

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* This wire must be connected to the (-) negative side of the parking brake system of your vehicle. Once you engage the parking brake system, you will be allowed to watch the video. Do not connect the pink wire to the battery, otherwise it will use up the power of battery.

Basic Operation of Mp4

Insert a MP4(AVI,MPEG4) disc into the slot, the unit will automatically switch on, if a disc is loaded, press SOURCE to start the playback.

Note:

* You can press **EJ** button on the head unit to eject the MP4 disc.

Number Buttons

you can select any tracks directly by using **(3) Number Buttons(0~9)**. The track you selected will be played automatically.

Note:

* This function is operated by using the remote control only.

Stop the playback

Note:

* Press in the monitor performs the same function.

Pause the Playback

Note:

* Press ③ on the head unit or 🖭 in the monitor performs the same function.

On Screen Display

Press **③ OSD** button the display shows:

Repeat Playing

During MP4(AVI,MPEG4) playback, first press **2** GOTO, and monitor shows *select* : --- , press your desired time of the playback by using number buttons. and press ENTER to set the status. Secondly press GOTO button, and the monitor shows: -:--:-, input your desired time, then press ENTER.

* This function is operated by using the remote control only.

Slow motion playback

During MP4(AVI,MPEG4) mode, press SLOW to slow forward or slow backward. There are speeds as follow:

Selecting Channel

During VCD status, repeatedly press **(**AUDIO button to select the following channel:



Selecting the corresponding channel to set the different sound characters.

Note:

* This function is operated by using the remote control only.

PBC Selector

During VCD status, first press ③ TITLE button, the PBC playback starts and the menu of entire disc appears on LCD. And then you can select your desired track by using ④ or ④ When a track is playing, you can press MENU to return to the menu, if you would like to end the track and select others. To cancel PBC playing, press ③ TITLE button again.

Note:

* PBC playing confirms to version 2.0 or above disc only.


Program Playing

During VCD/CD mode, press **(B) PROG**, the TFT displays the program menu.
