


The battery pack

1 Charge the battery pack until the CHARGE lamp lights off.




2 Insert the battery pack into the camera.



Firmly insert the battery pack all the way while pressing the lock lever with the tip of the battery.




1 Remove the body cap on the camera and packaging lid on the rear of the lens.



- Do not touch inside parts.
- If dust enters the camera, it may appear on the photo image. Do not leave the camera and lens without the caps. When you change the lens, do it quickly in a location free from dust.
- 2 Mount the lens by aligning the index marks as illustrated.




• Turn the lens until it clicks. Remove the lens cap during shootina.



2 Insert a memory card and select the type of the memory card you want to use using the memory card switch. Face side (SD memory card)



- For available memory cards, refer to the Instruction Manual.












- Shooting
- Set the mode dial to AUTO. Check that the LIVE VIEW/OVE switch is set to "LIVE VIEW."



- LIVE VIEW/OVE switch
- Hold the arip of the camera. Support the lens from below.
- 2 Check the subject on the LCD monitor.




- Pressing the shutter button halfway down and holding it activates the autofocus.
- 4 Press the shutter button fully down to shoot.
