# Front and Side View



### 1. LCD Touch Screen

Tap the screen with touch pen or finger to select menu commands or to enter information.

### 2. Battery Status Indicator

The indicator glows in bright amber color when battery is fully charged and in red color when charging.

### 3. microSD Slot

Receives microSD memory card for data access or memory expansion.

### 4. Mini-USB Port

Connects to USB Cable for data access or battery charging

### 5. Headphone Port

Connects to stereo headphones or headsets.

### 6. Reset Button

Press to reboot the device.

# <u>Rear and Top View</u>



### 1. Speaker

Emits sound, voice or music.

### 2. Power Button

Press to power ON/OFF device.



## NOTE:

Please always make sure that the device and any other external device connected to the device are powered off and unplugged from the power supply before attempting to connect the device to any external device.

## Inserting microSD Card



- To insert a microSD card, place connector towards device and card label towards the front side of the device.
- To remove a microSD card, gently press the edge of the card to release the safety lock and pull the card out of the slot.



## NOTE:

Please always make sure that no application is accessing the microSD card before extraction.

## Connecting to External USB Device (Charging)



- Flip open the protective rubber cover towards the front of the device.
- Insert USB connector into the appropriate USB port.
- Insert the other USB connector into USB port on PC to start charging.

# **Device Connections**

## **Connecting to Earphones**



- Flip open the protective rubber cover towards the front of the device.
- Insert earphone jack (earphones not included) into the appropriate earphone port to switch audio output from device speaker to earphone.



### NOTE:

Excessively loud volume is potentially detrimental to hearing. Please turn down the volume before connecting the earphone and gradually turn up the volume to a comfortable level.

## Connecting to Car Charger



- Flip open the protective rubber cover towards the front of the device.
- Insert USB connector into the appropriate USB port.
- Insert car charger connector into vehicle 5V accessory/cigarette socket to start charging.

### NOTE:

Please connect the car charger to vehicle 5V accessory/cigarette socket after vehicle engine is started to protect the device from sudden surges in current.

# About Rechargeable Battery

The device is equipped with a built-in rechargeable battery. Please fully charge the battery (for at least 8 hours) before initial use. The battery status indicator glows in red color when charging and turns bright amber color when charging is complete. Charging time is approximately 2 hours.

## Working conditions and precautions for the rechargeable battery

- Device with new batteries should be fully charged before initial use.
- Battery should only be used and charged when temperatures are between 0°  $\sim$  37°C.
- It is not necessary to start charging the device before the battery is fully discharged.




## NOTE:

Please connect the car charger to vehicle 5V accessory/cigarette socket after vehicle engine is started to protect the device from sudden surges in current.

# Using Mounting Cradle

### NOTE:



Please select an appropriate location on the dashboard or windshield where the device will not obstruct driver field of vision.

# **Device Mounting Procedures**

The device can be securely mounted on vehicle dashboard or windshield with the mounting cradle included. Please follow procedures below to operate mounting cradle:

- 1. Select an appropriate location on windshield or dashboard where the device and mounting cradle will not obstruct driver field of vision.
- 2. Please also make sure that the device has a clear view of sky to attain best GPS reception.



- Place device on the bracket with bottom positioned on the appropriate socket as illustrated by Arrow 1.
- Push on the top edge as illustrated by Arrow 2 to securely install device onto the cradle.
- Lift the suction cup lever and press the suction cup at desired location.
- Press down the suction cup lever as illustrated by Arrow 3 to secure the mounting cradle on the surface.
- Rotate the knob to adjust device to desired viewing angle.


# To Dismount Device

- 1. Push the tap on top of the mounting cradle to release the device.
- 2. Lift the suction cup lever to easily remove the suction cup from windshield or dashboard.





- 1. Press and hold **Power Button** to turn on device.
- Shortly after the greeting screen is shown, the main menu will be displayed.
- Tap the corresponding buttons with touch pen included to navigate various functions.
- Press and hold **Power Button** to turn off the device or to allow device to enter sleep mode.



 Tap Sleep icon to instruct device to enter sleeping mode or OFF icon to complete turn off the device.

Tap on **Navigation** icon to start navigation software. The options are displayed as below:



Tap **Destination** icon to start navigation function by entering an address or selecting a **Place Of Interest** (**POI**), a location on the map, or one of **Favorite** destinations. Recent destinations can also be displayed from the **Smart History**.



Tap **My Route** icon to display routing parameters including cancelling current route, selecting route alternatives, simulating navigation, and adding destination to **Favorites**. **NOTE**:

The button remains inactive when no destination is selected.



Tap **More...** icon to adjust software settings, go through Demo & Tutorial, execute additional applications, or received extra content from www.naviextras.com



Tap Show Map icon to start navigating on the map.



Tap Exit icon to stop navigation and exit the software.

- 2. Current country/state/town (location attributes) is set as default location.
- 3. Tap Select Street to continue or Back to return.
- 4. Tap location attributes desired to change its values.
- 5. After tapping a few characters, the device automatically matches character strings with names of location in database.
- 6. Tap 🗹 to confirm selection or 🥌 to correct entry.
- Tap List to browse a list of location names matching input. Tap an item to select.

In the navigation menu, tap Destination icon and then Find Places icon.



Displays a list of petrol stations along the route, around current position, or last known location



Displays a list of restaurants along the route, around current position, or last known location.



Displays a list of parking lots near destination.



Displays a list of accommodations near destination.



Displays all available POI near the following locations:

Around Here

Near current position.

In a City

In a desired city/town.



Route

Near destination of active route

Along the active route.





The Map screen displays a virtual view of current position and various other information such as Vehimarker represent current position, orange line showing the recommended route, buttons and data fields assisting navigating function.

- Information of current location is displayed at the top of the screen when destination is not selected. With a confirmed destination, next instruction of maneuver or next street/road in the route navigation will be displayed.
- Tap anywhere on the map to open quick menu with control options.
- Tap <sup>(1)</sup> to explore around the current location. Press directional buttons to navigate.
- Tap to toggle between distance reminders including remaining distance to destination, estimated time of arrival at destination, and remaining time of the trip.
- Tap = Menu to return to navigation menu

# Troubleshooting

Take steps described in the tables below to solve simple problems before contacting customer service.



### NOTE:

Immediately turn off the device and disconnect the power adapter if the device is not working properly. Never try to repair the unit without authorized professionals for it may damage the unit.

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE	POSSIBLE SOLUTION
Users can't turn	The adaptor doesn't connect well.	Connect the adaptor correctly.
	The built-in rechargeable battery is weak.	Use the adaptor to supply power or charge the battery.
There is no sound.	The volume may be turned down or mute.	Turn up the volume or turn on the sound output.
There is no picture.	The brightness may be turned down.	Adjust the brightness of the LCD.
The unit can't receive satellite signals or can't orient.	The unit may be obstructed by buildings or metal block.	Make sure to use the unit out of room; if in the vehicle, you can use the external GPS antenna to solve this problem.

# Troubleshooting

### PROBLEM

## POSSIBLE CAUSE POSSIBLE SOLUTION

The unit can receive signals now but can't then; signals received are not stable.

The built-in rechargeable battery is weak.	Use the adaptor to supply power or charge the battery.
The unit may be obstructed by veil, such as heat insulation paper.	Remove the veil.
Swing of the unit is too great.	Avoid great swing of the unit.
