- + Listening at high volume (85 dB and above) for an extended period of time may harm your hearing.
- + For your protection, use the player in a well lit area where LCD screen will not overly strain your eyes.

Before you start! +Charging

To charge iAUDIO E2, use the USB cable to connect the product to the PC.

iAUDIO E2 supports USB charging only.



* Connect part 1 first, and then connect part 2.

The red LED lamp appears when charging, and it takes about 1.5 hours before it is fully charged.

The green LED lamp appears when fully charged.





- If you use the 'Safely remove the hardware' function in Windows to remove the USB from iAUDIO E2, charging will not take place.
- When charging the player for the first time or the player has not been charged for an extended time, fully charge the battery before use.
- IAUDIO E2 has a built-in Lithium Polymer battery. To prolong the life of the battery, it is recommended that you charge the device frequently, as opposed to fully discharging and then charging the device.
- When connected to a USB hub, the player may not charge properly. Please try connecting the player directly to a USB port on the PC.
- For safety during charging, use USB cable approved by COWON SYSTEMS, Inc.

- Use the USB cable to connect iAUDIO E2 to the PC. (Connect 1→2)
- Check whether the LED lamp on the back of iAUDIO E2 turns green (fully charged) or red (charging in progress).
- The contents of iAUDIO E2 can be viewed by using My Computer or Windows Explorer while it is connected.
- 4. Copy music files to iAUDIO E2.
- When done, click the system tray to safely remove iAUDIO 9 from the PC.

7. Safely remove the hardware and disconnect the USB cable.



- The player can recognize up to 100 folders, and up to 1,000 files
- Disconnect the product after performing 'Safely remove hardware' function.

iAUDIO E2

+ Firmware Upgrade

Firmware is software that is embedded within the hardware. Upgrading it can enhance system stability and provide additional features.

The performance and usage of iAUDIO E2 may be changed through the firmware without any prior notice, and slight malfunctioning may occur in some firmware.

How to Upgrade the Firmware

- Download the latest firmware from the SUPPORT section of the website (http://www.COWON.com).
- 2. Use the USB cable to connect iAUDIO E2 to the PC.
- 3. Unzip the firmware file and copy it to the root folder of iAUDIO E2.
- Perform 'Safely remove the hardware' function before disconnecting the USB cable..
- 5. When you turn on iAUDIO E2, the firmware will be upgraded automatically.
- 6. Turn on iAUDIO E2 again, and confirm that a music file can play back normally.

Fully charge the player before upgrading the firmware. Do not turn off the player before firmware upgrade is complete. It may damage

- the product, and will void any warranty.
- Back up any important data before the firmware upgrade as any data stored on the device may be deleted during the process. COWON accepts no liability for any loss of data.

+LED Lamp Description

The iAUDIO E2 LED can display either green or red.

The following table provides a detailed description of the colors and the LED status.

+Music Playback and Using the Product

[POWER on/off and music playback]

- You can turn on the product by pressing the POWER button on the right. As an indication, the green LED lamp blinks momentarily and music starts playing.
- With the power turned on, connect the earphones to the iAUDIO E2, and then music will automatically play. Once the earphones are removed, music playback stops.
- More than one minute after the earphones are removed, iAUDIO E2 automatically turns off.
- When there are no music files in the unit memory, the green LED lamp will blink, and you will hear no sound.
- 2. iAUDIO E2 can be turned off with a beep sound by pressing the POWER button.





[Adjusting the Volume]

Use + and – button to adjust the volume.

- Maximum volume for iAUDIO E2 is 40.



Protect your hearing with iAUDIO E2's auto volume feature. IAUDIO E2 automatically plays music if an earphone is connected and powered on. When the last volume setting is higher than level 20, it will be automatically adjusted to level 20 when turned on next time. In case the volume setting was lower than level 20, there will be no change.

[Selecting a track]

Briefly press FF/REW button to select the music track.

- Briefly press FF button to skip to next track.
- Briefly press REW button to return to the previous track, while when the music plays for more than 5 seconds it goes back to the

beginning of the track



+Music Playback and Using the Product

[Rewind/Fast Forward]

Press and hold FF/REW button to rewind or fast forward.

- A beep will sound during FF/REW.



[Setting up the sound effect]

Press the menu button to assign various sound effects.

- iAUDIO E2 is equipped with 9 sound effects featuring BBE+ technology.
- Each preset is announced by a voice guide when pressing the Menu button.
- Sound effect sequence as follows:

Press and hold menu button to activate shuffle function. (vice guide: 'Shuffle On'). The shuffle function plays back stored music files in a random sequence.

Press and hold menu button again to deactivate shuffle function.



[Reset]

Press reset button on the rear of the unit to cut the power to iAUDIO E2.

- Use a pencil or clip that has a pointed end when you reset the product, and use caution not to press the LED lamp next to the Reset button instead.

To convert music CD into an audio file, click the Rip button (CD ripping) in the upper left-hand corner.



3. When the audio CD extraction window appears, confirm that the name and information of each track is correctly displayed. If the track name close not appear or the txt appears broken, press the 'Read from CD Data Base Server' button as illustrated below to update the ID3 tag, In some cases, certain CDs may not have information on the Internet CD database server. In this case, the user can directly enter CD information.

7. Copy/move the converted audio file to the memory of iAUDIO E2.

+Troubleshooting

+ My booting speed seems slower.

* When the battery is not enough or has been completely discharged. * When the player turned off by pressing reset button.

+ I am still confused even after reading the manual.

COMON webstley/www.COMON.com) provides support for users of COMON products with FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions). Users are storogly encouraged to check out the webstle for further information regarding product usages and firmware upgrades. For inst/vicual inquiries, please contact us on-hie as we will by to help you as best as we can.

+ I would like to set the device as factory default. To delete all files in iAUDIO E2, connect it to a PC, and format them as FAT32 files. Once formatted, all files in the product will be deleted.

+ The player does not turn on.

If the battery is completely discharged, charge the battery before you start the player. The charging time may your depending on the battery before status. If the player does not work at all, press the RESET button on the rear side. For your information, RESET will just deconnect the power and does not damage the product or delete any files stored on the device.

+ I can't hear any sound.

Check If the volume is set to '0". Check If there is any file available in the player. If there is no file in the player, you will not hear any sound. Please note that compted files will result in a noise or discontinued playback. Make sure the exphones are connected properly. Impurities in the exphone jack can cause a noise.

+ Computer cannot recognize the player when connected.

Try the RESET button in the back. If you experience a fequent deconnection or unstable connectivity, connect the palver directly the USB port of the PC, rather than a separate USB hub. As COWON products use the USB connection for the main power system, unstable power supply can cause a connection future.

+ Memory capacity of the player is different or smaller than specified.

The memory capacity indicated by Windows may be different from that indicated by the memory manufacturer. The actual capacity will be reduced from the original size because some space of the memory should be used as the system area for normal operation.

+Troubleshooting

+ The player does not play properly when memory is full. For the player to function properly, it requires at least 5 MB of space for saving settings and other system files.

+ PC connection is unstable.

Connect the player directly to the USB port of the PC. When connected to a laptop, try removing other connected USB hardware, or try connecting to PCMCIA USB host card.

Fully charge the product, or connect the product to the pc while charging with genuine COWON adapter.

+ Files do not appear in the product when files are transferred with a MAC computer. Format the product as MS-DOS(FAT), and transfer the files.

+ Battery Replacement



The rechargeable batteries have limited number of charge cycles, and it will require a replacement as capacity to hold power will eventually diminish.

The rechargeable batteries in COWON products should be replaced only by official COWON service centers. Please contact batteryreplace@cowon.com for more information on official COWON service centers.

+ Product Disposal



COWON products contain built-in-rechargeable batteries, and must be separately disposed from household waste.
